

Administrative History Note:

The Lac du Flambeau Boarding School for the Chippewa Indians living on the La du Flambeau Reservation in Wisconsin was opened in 1895 under the direction of the La Pointe Agency. In 1907 it was made independent and given agency status. A major reorganization in 1927 consolidated the La Pointe, Laona, Red Cliff, and Mackinac Agencies with the Lac du Flambeau Agency, and in 1933 the Hayward School was added. The consolidated agency was responsible for Chippewa and Potawatomi Indians living in Wisconsin and Michigan. In 1936, the Lac du Flambeau Agency was superseded by the Great Lakes Agency.


